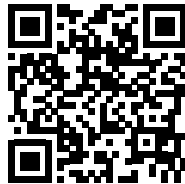

As you can see from the above table here is the status of the Pasadena Scottish Rite and the membership dues. It also compares our Valley with Orient and Jurisdiction. Of concern is the 140 that are arrears. Some of those hundred 140 will be on the suspension list come December 15.



We need to increase the number in current dues and Life Membership and we need to decrease the number in arrears and exempt. Now is the time to purchase a Life Membership. Presently the rates are as follows:

- Under age 49 - 21 times annual dues or \$1995.00
- 50 to 54 inclusive - 19 times annual dues \$1805.00
- 55 to 59 inclusive - 17 times annual dues \$1615.00
- 60 to 64 inclusive - 14 times annual dues \$1330.00
- 65 and over - 11 times annual dues \$1045.00

Beginning on January 1, 2017 the cost increases substantially as follows:
